GMCM I MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION EXPLANATION

NAME(s) – Nicknames, when indicated are used.

STREET – If you have two seasonal addresses, include the second one on a separate note. Indicate the month when to start mailing to each address.

CITY, STATE & ZIP CODE – Same as above.

PHONES – An annual roster is published in the first quarter and sent out with the GMCM I newsletter. Roster addendums are sent out with the other three GMCM I newsletters. If you do not wish to have your phone number included, please cross it out. Similar for cell phones.

EMAIL Addresses are not included in the rosters for security reasons.

MAKE – Ownership of a GMC Motorhome for club membership is desirable but not mandatory. If you are presently a non-GMC owner, please indicate. If you indicated that you own more than one GMC, the latest model is listed.

YEAR – 1973 through 1978. The last digit before the (V) in the TZE serial number indicates the year the motorhome was manufactured by GMC.

LENGTH – 23 foot or 26 foot, unless the motorhome was extended by one of its owners after manufacturing. The next to last digit before the V in the TZE serial number indicates the length.

MODEL – The model in most cases is lettered on the front sides of the vehicle (Palm Beach – Sequoia – Royale, etc.). The model can be somewhat confusing since General Motors used ZEO & RPO numbers to designate models, however, common usage refers to the outside name that is really the interior decor in most cases. Models, by year can be found at <http://www.gmcmi.com/gmcmh-basic-information/>. If your vehicle is a Transmode (without a factory interior) or has been revised, write CUSTOM.

FLOOR PLANS – The floor plans are shown at www.gmcmi.com/models-floorplans/ and show most of the more common layouts. All original GMC and Coachman interiors are shown on these sheets.

VEHICLE ID NUMBER – This number can be found on the passenger side firewall by opening the front access door which is located over the front grille. (Engine oil filler pipe is inside the same door.)

The number is on a metal plate about 12 inches inside the door and appears as TZE_____V10_____

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE – This number could prove helpful at our Conventions in case of illness.
